

CONNECTIONS Program in a nutshell

If a student has more than 4 unexcused absences he/she will lose credit in that class and possibly jeopardize an on time graduation. CONNECTIONS is a program that helps students to both regain credit that was lost in previous semesters and to prevent credit loss in current semesters.

How it works:

The student must sign a contract that has 2 major provisions.

- First, and most importantly, he/she must realize that they can no longer have any unexcused absences in ANY classes. After signing the contract, if unexcused absences continue the contract is void and credit will be lost.
- Secondly, he/she must make up for the time they missed in class by spending time in the Ozone. How much time depends on how many absences he/she has and/or how much credit has been lost.
 - Current semester classes: Student must spend 1 hour for every unexcused absence after the first 4. So if he/she has 10 unexcused absences 6 hours must be spent in the Ozone.
 - Past Semester Class (credit loss is already on the transcript): The student must spend 18 hours in the Ozone for every lost credit.
