## **Snack**

A snack calendar will be posted on the website each month. The date in which your child's name is, is the day you provide snack for. Please individually package the snacks in snack size bags for easy distribution. If you would like to provide vegetables or fruit please wash and cut them up before bringing it in. We have 23 students in each class. You will only provide for your child's class.

## **Birthday treats and invitations**

Please alert the school office and teacher of any medical conditions or allergies your child may have. ALL MEDICATION must be registered and administered in the health room

## **Clothing**

Please be sure your child is dressed for any possible weather changes. We will go outside in all weather including snow. Please make sure that your child's clothing is labeled, so that if it gets miss placed it can find its way home. Please do not send in umbrellas on rainy days. Hats may be worn outside, but they should be taken off when inside the building.

Toys are NOT allowed in school. We ask that the students leave them at home. The only exception is on their big cheese day. They may bring them into share but then they must leave with the parents.
