



Construction Update Louisville Middle School Oct. 31 – Nov. 7, 2008

Construction Overview

Portable classrooms were installed this summer. The 1939 portion of the building was demolished and construction crews began work on the foundation for the new addition.

What you need to know

Parking	Main Street & Jefferson offer excellent parent parking plus our staff parking has (3) handicapped spots as needed.
Pick up/Drop off	Pick up and drop off for buses and parents has been moved to Lafayette Street on the south side of the building. This area is "Pirates Park." If you are looking to pick up after 5 pm, the main doors are now available to enter school.
Traffic	Please treat the intersection by Pirates Park (Jefferson Street) as a 4-Way stop.
Bike and Pedestrian Access	Thanks for utilizing the extra bike racks on the west side of LMS. Too many kiddos still not locking bikes!
Deliveries *NEW INFORMATION	Hot tar roofing materials arrived. Staircase to 2 nd floor installed. Hot pot for tar as far from LMS as possible. Uni-vac units on roof. More next week.
Utility Disruption	Lots of fire alarm and computer switches were repaired this past week.
Noise	Wet saw for brick work is noticeable south of LMS. Roof welding continues. Tar roofing sounds. Back up beepers produce a constant sound on the south.
Smells *NEW INFORMATION	The roofing (hot tar) is now occurring so side air intakes are turned off to reduce smell.
Evacuation Routes	New drill for November will work on interior safety drills.
Daily routine/internal traffic patterns (lunch, recess, etc.)	Lunch recess in Pirates Park is going great! Kids have memorized all the loops to and from their classes.
Construction Club *NEW INFORMATION	Next club date is Nov. 7 th at 12 pm and Nov. 21 st at Noon. November 7th club meeting is open to both lunch periods so students can view the architectural plans with our project architects.
