Your job as a persuasive writer is to get those reasons together and present them effectively. Here's an easy way to organize your persuasive writing:

1. **The beginning:** Introduce your subject and state your opinion on it.
2. **The middle:** Here's where you present all the reasons the reader should agree with you. You'll want to organize these reasons in a list before you begin writing- this will make the process of writing go much faster and make your writing much more effective.
3. **The end:** Restate your opinion and some of the important facts that support it.
