## **FUNDRAISE YOUR FEES**

All band families (jazz, concert, marching) may take advantage of this opportunity to “fundraise your fees”. The profits earned from your sales are split between individual Student Accounts and the FBBO general fund. 40% of the profits go to your designated individual Student Account. 60% of profits go to the FBBO general fund which supports all of the jazz, concert, and marching bands through covering the costs of music, transportation, competition and festival

entry fees, instrument and equipment maintenance, uniform cleaning, clinicians and additional instructional personnel and materials, and scholarships.

## Important Sale Dates and Instructions

### 2. COMPLETE ORDER FORMS & COLLECT PAYMENT:

\*Please use the order forms provided which specify items and prices.

\*Put the student's name on each order form (to ensure proper credit to Student Accounts).

\*When taking an order, **print** each customer's first and last name and telephone number.

\*Please use a pen.

**\*Collect payment at the time of the sale (checks payable to FBBO). An order will be complete and accepted ONLY if full payment is included with the order.**

\*Do not send cash. Replace cash with your own personal check.

**\*\*\*PLEASE COLLECT SEPARATE CHECKS** (all made out to FBBO) for Equal Exchange and Scrip sales. We know this will take a little extra effort. We can't emphasize enough the importance **of collecting separate checks for Equal Exchange and Scrip sales!** **This will help us to conserve the** volunteer hours devoted to accounting for this fund raiser and ensure accuracy so that Student Accounts receive appropriate credit.
