



General Fees Overview

Note to Parents: *This information will assist you in anticipating general fees for the school year. Fees must be paid at registration. If you need financial assistance, please contact Kory Beaber at 303-447-5330.*

Classroom Fees: (Costs Vary) Some classes have fees for materials. Fees vary by class. See reverse of this sheet.

Student Planner: (\$5.00) Student planners are part of the curriculum and are referenced by teachers and administrators throughout the school year. Students will receive their planners the first day of school, not at registration.

Student Activity Pass: (\$35.00) This fee allows students to attend any Fairview regular-season, home-game athletic event. The activity pass is printed directly on students' ID cards, which students receive at registration. If you choose not to purchase this pass, athletic event tickets may be purchased at the gate of each game at the regular price.

Post-Graduate Fee: (\$5.00) The Post-Graduate Center provides students with valuable information and support about opportunities available to them after they graduate from Fairview. This fee allows the Center to maintain updated records and to provide guidance counseling to students and families about college choices and other post-graduate opportunities.

Senior Graduation Fee: (\$20.00) The family of each senior is asked to contribute \$20.00 to offset the cost of the graduation ceremony at the Coors Event Center.

Student Directory: (\$4.00) Student Directories will be available to pick up at Back-to-School Night. You may purchase as many copies as you like. Please be sure to submit your *Student Directory Permission Form* if you want your information in the directory.

Freshman Seminar/Link Program Fee: (\$5.00) This fee will help fund these valuable programs' academic and social activities for incoming freshmen and for our link leaders.

Knight Quest - Fairview Parent Organization (FPO) Donations: FPO is funded solely by parent donations. These donations support many Fairview needs that are not funded by the BVSD budget, such as additional instructional needs, technology, staff development, parent education, building and grounds upgrades, and our parent newsletter. FPO is a 501(c) non-profit organization and donations are tax deductible.

Knights Club (formerly the Sports Booster Club) Donation Form: These donations are used to fund athletic awards programs and purchases of equipment, materials, and uniforms not available through the BVSD budget.
