Principal's Report (Don Stensrud):

- **Open enrollment:** Almost over. Unlikely to have as many 9th graders next year as this year (low 500s).
- **Financial Report:** Funding is good for next year, as are FTEs. Some spending on technology, parking situation, front of building, etc. For Fall 2011, all monies previously reduced will be restored, as will staffing ratio. Some equipment left over as a result of the bond improvements may be sold to raise money for the school.
- **Parking:** Senior parking lot modifications include sidewalk on north side, approval by city for right turn only out of lot onto Gillaspie, and moving bus stop to the east side of the horseshoe.
- **Late start:** Surveys have been issued to get feedback. Boulder High would agree to late start in tandem with Fairview, which would make it easier to coordinate transportation. District is thinking of one day a week late start but Fairview would prefer consistent increase in late start. Transportation constrains starting at 8:00, as opposed to 8:25 am.
- **CASP scores:** Discussion of achievement gap. Some students showing unsatisfactory CSAP scores but doing OK in school.

New Business:

- Mike Heath is the new Boulder County Police Department school resource officer (SRO). He is replacing the previous officer and his role is to collaborate with school. Moving to 3 full-time security. Discussion of lockdown drills and changes in police models since Columbine.
