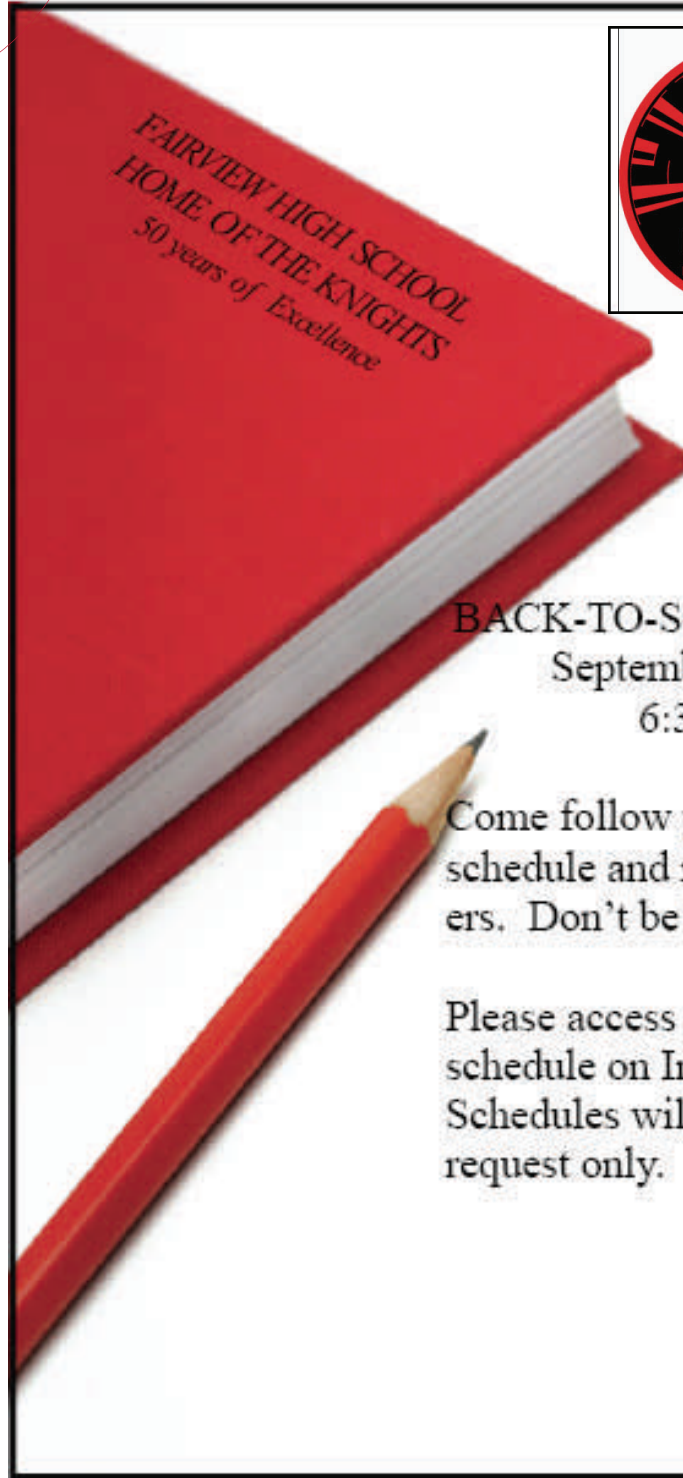

Families receiving a list are not obligated to carpool and can use the list as a reference or in the event they have temporary transportation needs.

RideArrangers is a federally funded program of the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG). Since the only goal is to help reduce traffic congestion and pollution, you can be assured your information will only be shared with Fairview H.S. families and not with other businesses or agencies. Please note your home address will not be provided to families, only your home intersection.
