Dr. Delisle's focus on the social/emotional development of gifted children and strategies for teachers and parents to support gifted kids' growth and development are the topics of many of his books and articles. Dr. Jim Delisle has taught gifted children and those who work on their behalf for more than 30 years. Jim retired from Kent State University recently after 25 years of service as a professor of special education. Throughout his career, Jim has taken time away from college teaching to return to his "classroom roots", volunteering as a 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teacher. Jim taught gifted middle school students one day a week between 1998 – 2008 in the Twinsburg, Ohio Public Schools. Jim is the author of more than 250 articles and 15 books. The practical nature of Jim's presentations is a direct result of his frequent intervention into the world of schools.

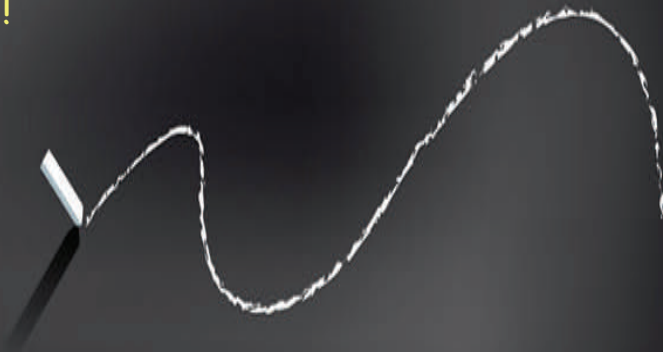
Due to our new on-line pay system we have posted to your students fee tab everything available for your family to purchase. The balance due is not the balance owed by your family it is just what is available to purchase.
