

How Booster Club Works

Booster Club is here to support and enhance excellence in Monarch High School student organizations and activities.

Membership Dues – each family pays \$35 per year for membership, of which \$5 goes back to the club/sport designated. To encourage early enrollment, we now hold a drawing early in the fall to WIN \$100 (\$50 in free Booster Club clothing, \$50 to your favorite club/sport).

Parent Representative: To become a Parent Representative for your club/sport we ask the following:

- Attend monthly meetings – just by attending the monthly meetings you are automatically entered in our monthly drawing to win \$100 for your club or sport!
- Work at least 2 clothing booths during the year
- Pass along information to your group so they can participate in the fundraisers.

(If you know you won't be able to be a Parent Representative next year, start looking for another parent to step up and work with you toward the end of the year)

Fundraisers – We have several large fundraisers a year. This is a way for you to help raise money for your club/sport. A certain portion of each sale goes directly back to your club/sport. We ask that you pass on information to your group so they can participate.

Clothing Booths – We help to promote school pride by selling clothing and Letter Jackets throughout the year.

Community/Family Involvement – We have a program where businesses or families can purchase plaques or signs to be hung at Monarch. It is a great way to show your support for Monarch High School and for businesses to advertise. A certain portion of each sale goes directly back to your club or sport.

Apply for a Grant - By participating in Booster Club meetings and fundraisers the club/sport can earn direct money for their organization and apply for a yearly grant from the MHS Booster Club. The Parent Representative should work with the coach/sponsor to find out what their needs are and submit a **Request for Financial Help** to the Executive Board.
