## **1. Introductions - Reps and Attendees**

## **2. Fall Fundraiser Update**

### **a. Wreaths and Poinsettias - Dulci**

- Total sold: \$7300. Boosters will get \$585, and clubs and groups get \$1,722.
- Annie sent out a sign up sheet for the Pick Up date, Nov. 30th.
- Still need a chair for next year.

### **b. Hoodies for the Holidays - Jane/Cristi**

- Total sold to date: \$1,200 to date. Will fulfill these orders and pass them out next week. Will have another order deadline of the 18th of Nov., and will have 10 on hand available for the Wreath Pick Up, as well as forms for more orders. Will even have another order after that (before Christmas).
- Reps need to remind their club/sport of new deadline.

## **3. Sign Program Update - Heather Cracraft**

a. Heather passed out information sheet about sign program, and will put it up on the website soon.

b. 90-10 split on the profits (90% goes to sport/club, 10% to Booster Club). Signs are in gym, the turf field, softball field, and baseball field. Signs stay up year round. This is a pilot program. The sign is vinyl. The sign can be renewed each year. Discount for multiple signs. Signs are 3x6. Application was passed out, but will also be on the website. Signs will be hung twice a year. Pricing structure is on handout, and will be on website.

c. Reps need to check with Heather to see if the business they are targeting is already part of the program - so we don't inundate the local business community with multiple requests for signs. Sales drive is Nov. 9 through Jan. 11.

## **4. Cave Update/Signups - Annie**

- It's been open every volleyball game.
- Annie has the procedure sheet done, and is hanging in the Cave.

- All our inventory is now in the Cave, not in other storage now.
- Annie passed out the sign up sheet, which is also on-line.
- The Cave takes the place of a winter fundraiser - as we are quite busy.
- So far have sold \$1200 worth of clothing at the Cave.

## **5. Booster Club Grants**

- a. Increased grants from \$700 to \$800, and CapEx requests from \$1000 to \$1200.
- b. If Poms send in paperwork, we can transfer another \$100 to them. Softball got \$1200, Baseball got \$1200, and Wrestling got \$800.
- c. The request forms are on the website.

## **6. Financial Update - Lisa**

- Profit Loss sheet was passed out, and it details our current financial health, and grants and monies given to clubs/sports to date.
- Cash Forecast sheet was passed out. We believe Booster Club will have about \$10,000 to give to Bleachers.

## **7. Bleacher Update - Susan Sawicki**

- Obtained three bids with three tiers of estimates. Susan met with Mark Sibley and Jerry Anderson - both are very excited about the possibility of bleachers, especially before the next graduation (which would save \$14,000 per year). The options are a smaller bank of bleachers, a large bank, and a large bank with a press box. The configuration chosen will be determined by the amount of money raised. BVSD will kick in some amount of money. Once we've raised the money, it will take 45 days to install the bleachers. Highest cost option is \$150k to \$195k.
- Susan reached out to the mayors of Superior and Louisville. The mayors wanted to know what the parent contribution was. Susan will have lunch with the mayors. After that, it's time to go the public. Will hold a community meeting at MHS to talk about the bleachers to the public. Susan polled parents at a Pirates game, and many were ready to write a check on the spot.
- Clubs and sports can donate their CapEx grant to the bleachers. Cheer is ok with that, so far.

## **8. PTSO Update - Annie**

- They've paid out mini grants of \$16,000 so far this year. They have many committees that need to be filled. Info is up on their website.

### **9. Chairs Still Needed / Rep Forms**

- a. Still need Fall Wreath rep, and the Spring Plant rep.
- b. Also need people to help read scholarship apps - work in April.
- c. Still need a rep form, which is different from membership form: Boys' Lacrosse, Mtn Biking, FBLA, TSA. These sports need a rep Boys Swimming and Diving, Girl's Soccer and Girls' Tennis.
