2. Fall Fundraiser

- Hoodies took in nearly \$2000, not quite what we took in last year, but still very good. Some leftover sweatshirts -- will be available in the Cave.
- Still need someone to take over Wreath and Poinsettias.
- Still need someone to take over Spring Plant fundraiser - Marion Sewell is interested.

3. Sign program update - Heather

- Four locations for signs: gym, turf field, softball field, baseball field.
- Signs are 3' x 6'.
- Profit per sign to team is over \$300. Split is 10% to Booster Club, 90% directly to sport.

- There was a suggestion to have PTSO take over the Alive at 25 program that Dr. Anderson wants to put on the day before prom. Ciel will try to get a PTSO member to take responsibility for bringing it to MoHi.
