**Post Graduate Center:** A place where students and parents can learn more about college and career opportunities.

**Library Media Center:** Assist staff with shelving, inventory or cataloging of books during school hours.

**Tutoring Center:** During school hours, assist students in the Tutoring Center with homework and special projects.

**School Accountability Committee (SAC)/Parent Teacher Organization:** Meets each month, usually the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday, 6 – 7:30 p.m. This is a great opportunity to meet other parents and get to know school administrators. Get informed, ask questions, assist with some school functions, as well as discuss school improvement issues.

**Special Projects:** Called as needed, i.e.: After Prom, chaperone field trips, etc.

**Staff Care:** Plan and assist with ways to show care and support for our staff. Bring food for Parent/Teacher Conference days in the fall and spring, Teacher Appreciation Week (May), etc.

**Office Help:** Copy Room Support (anytime), Phone Receptionist (afternoon), Counseling Office Support (morning), other office support; i.e. collating, filing, etc. (afternoon).

**PEN (Parent Engagement Network):** Meets once a month to address how to assist with current events at CHS and to determine other ways of supporting students, staff, administrators and the parent community on an ongoing basis.

**CHS Parent Mentor Program:** Be a mentor for incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade parents; provide support and information as they transition into CHS. The commitment is approximately 2-3 hours between May and October.

**After School Activity Support:** Supervise games; assist in selling tickets at games: Game days from 5:30 p.m. through halftime.

**Health Room:** Dispense band aids and ice packs as needed and supervise students who need to use the Health Room. A first aid class is required, but no dispersal of medicine will be done by volunteers.

**Grant Writing:** Write and submit grants that support students.

**Exam Proctors:** Proctor ACT/AP/IB Exams during school hours in April and May.

Training will be provided.
