<b>Outstanding</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Information is true, interesting and detailed</li> <li>- You've use more than 2 sources</li> <li>- Sources are cited so your audience understands where you got your information</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Information is arranged in a logical and interesting order</li> <li>- It is extremely clear</li> <li>- Standard format is enhanced, eg, report might include maps and charts; a map might include a close-up detailed section, etc</li> </ul>	<p>Exceptional and consistent attention to all the items mentioned below.</p>
<b>Acceptable</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Information is true</li> <li>- there is enough so that the reader learns something new</li> <li>- you've addressed all the basic requirements of the assignment</li> <li>- you've synthesized information from at least 2 sources</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- information is arranged in a logical order</li> <li>- it makes sense</li> <li>- you use a format that is standard for the project,</li> <li>- eg, map has a key and labels, report has introduction and conclusion, etc.</li> </ul>	<p><u>Writing</u>: nearly perfect mechanics, readable writing, neat paper</p> <p><u>Speaking or singing</u>: Loud enough, no mumbling, appropriate pauses, eye contact, memorized (if required)</p> <p><u>Artistic</u> (maps, models, etc): neat, useful and legible labeling, appropriate use of color, appropriately durable</p>
<b>Needs more work</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- information is partially wrong</li> <li>- not enough information</li> <li>- used only 1 source</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- information is confusing or unclear</li> <li>- format is missing some expected elements</li> </ul>	<p>Weak in several areas mentioned above.</p>
