

**WELCOME NEW ORCHESTRA AND BAND MEMBERS!**  
**The following is a checklist for supplies you will need for instrumental music**

## ORCHESTRA

- An instrument of proper size
- A folding music stand
- ***Essential Elements For Strings 2000*** Book 1 for your instrument (*plusDVD opt.*)
- Rosin (bass players should get “Pops” brand)
- A cleaning cloth—an old cotton cloth is the best
- **Cello and Bass** players will need a rock stop (endpin holder)
- **Violin and Viola** players will need a shoulder rest
- Pencil
- Pitch pipe (recommended for tuning at home)

## BAND

- A folding music stand
- ***Accent on Achievement*** (Book 1)
- Flutes need a flute rod and a cotton or lint-free cloth
- Reed instruments need a swab with a weight (lint-free material or handkerchief style. Silk is the best, or a cotton/rayon blend is great, a minimum of three reeds hardness 1\_ or 2, a reed holder (a reed guard is the best) and cork grease
- Brass instruments need valve/slide oil, tuning slide grease and a flexible cleaner
- Percussion players will need drum sticks and bell mallets
- All instruments will need a polishing cloth appropriate for your instrument’s finish
