

Dear Douglass Families,

We are closing in on the start of the 2010-2011 school year! Please read this e-mail as it contains important dates and details about some changes to the registration process for this fall.

All registration forms are available at Douglass's web site – www.bvsd.org/schools/douglass. Look on the main page for "Back to School" forms, which you can print out and bring to school on Monday, August 16 at our registration time from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

This year, we will have an option for paying school fees on line – information will be sent to families as soon as the pay portal is activated by the district. If you prefer to pay fees by check, you may bring that check with your registration paperwork to the school on Monday, August 16, from 10:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Our PTO will have a table set up to update information for the student directory and to sell King Soopers reloadable gift cards as a part of our on-going fundraising. PTO will also offer pre-sales for the yearbook at this time.

Also on Monday, August 16, you are welcome to bring school supplies to your child's classroom and greet your teacher from 11 a.m. to noon. At noon, the teachers and I will begin our afternoon meeting, so this is just a drop off supplies and shake your new teacher's hand time.

The first day of school is Tuesday, August 17. Tuesday/Thursday Kindergarten students begin on this day; Monday/Wednesday Kindergarteners start school on Wednesday, August 18 and also report to school all day on Friday, August 20. No school on Friday, August 20 for Tuesday/Thursday Kindergarteners.

Fifth grade families, note that your Back-To-School Night will be held on Wednesday, August 18, at 6:30 p.m. This event will include details about the September overnight excursion in Estes Park.

All other families, Back-To-School Night is Tuesday, August 24, also at 6:30 p.m. We will begin in the gym with introductions of new staff, a greeting and announcements from me, and information from our PTO. Classroom presentations will take place from 7 to 8:00 p.m.
