

Summit Ambassadors Club

The purpose of the Ambassadors Club is to assist students and families in learning more about Summit.

Student Ambassadors will:

- Host “shadow students” on student visitation days in February
- Act as tour guides and share information about Summit during school tours
- Speak to students at Parent Information Nights
- Help with the first day of school for incoming students

We are looking for students with the following qualities:

- Friendly and outgoing
- Strong interpersonal skills (can be good hosts and hostesses)
- Enjoys sharing one’s enthusiasm for Summit with others (proud and positive)
- Interested in developing one’s leadership skills
- Strong work ethic (able to miss class time and complete missed work in a timely manner)
- Strong attendance record
- Positive school behavior (respects Summit’s school rules and expectations, as delineated in the ‘Student Behavior’ section, pages 6-7 of the Student Planner).

The Ambassador Club Selection Process:

- Student Ambassadors interested in participating in this program should submit the Ambassador Club Candidate Form to Ms. Troup by December 4th.
- The Administration Team will review candidate forms. Students with poor work habits, poor attendance and/or behavior records (determined by office referrals and grades) will not be eligible for participation.
- Eligible candidates will be presented to sixth grade faculty. Teachers are given the opportunity to review the list and indicate those students whom they feel *do* and *do not* meet the program’s expectations.
- Students deemed ineligible for participation will be notified by the counselor and have an opportunity to meet and discuss the areas of concern. This is done with the intention of providing a teachable moment and an opportunity to set goals for improvement. Parents will also be notified and other opportunities for meaningful involvement in the school will be emphasized.
- Approved candidates will be submitted for a lottery system selection. Twelve boys and twelve girls will be selected, lottery style, for participation in the Ambassador Program for the year (December to December). You will be notified on December 7th. Our first meeting will be held Monday, December 14th at lunch.
